Frank Lloyd Wright's World Heritage Buildings

Thurs., April 10 at 7p

In 2019, UNESCO placed 8 buildings by Frank Lloyd Wright onto the World Heritage List. Titled The 20th Century Architecture of Frank Lloyd Wright, this list puts Wright's work onto the same stage as sites like Egypt's pyramids, the Grand Canyon, the Great Wall of China, and the Taj Mahal. Taliesin historian Keiran Murphy will give a presentation on this inscription, and its 8 Wright buildings (two in Wisconsin!).

Join us for an all-ages egg hunt around the library! We'll have an early round for the littlest hunters, followed by a second round for older hunt experts! Treats and fun in the Community Room afterwards. This event WILL happen regardless of weather. Dress for outdoor fun if weather permits, indoor if too inclement.
